# What is WiRe?

**Our aim is to make local resources (groups, clubs & services) which can help to keep people active, healthy and connected within their local community easier to find.**

**This will be achieved by adding the details of local resources to a Renfrewshire-only collection within a larger, national database called ALISS (A Local Information System for Scotland).**



# Background to WiRe

WiRe is an online portal which provides people with up-to-date information about local clubs, groups and activities across Renfrewshire in one place.

It offers information on social, educational & other activities to support wellbeing.

## **WiRe can support you to;**

- Improve your health or self-manage conditions.
- Get out and meet new people in your local area.
- Find out what you can do if you are new to the area.
- Make use of your Self-Directed Support budget.
- Promote your group, club or activity.
